



AGREEMENT ON RECEIVING DONATIONS FROM THE DRUGSTARS PLATFORM

THIS AGREEMENT is made in November 2020

BETWEEN

Øjenforeningen / Ny Kongensgade 20, 1557 København V (the "Health Charity")

AND

DrugStars ApS, Emdrupvej 28 A, 4, 2100 Copenhagen. CVR: 36893974 (the "Donator"),
collectively referred to as the "Parties".

The health charity accepts donations from the DrugStars platform based on the following terms:

1. The obligations of DrugStars

1.1 The Donation

The donator provides donations to the health charity based on user activation of stars in the DrugStars app. DrugStars is committed to donating 20 % of their revenue. The stars are a distribution vote, the more stars an organization gets the larger share of the 20 %.

The donator will collect user activations and make the financial transaction of the donation to the health charity on an annual basis.

1.2. The following business rules applies to the DrugStars platform.

The DrugStars platform comprises:

- a. Companies that contribute with sponsor funding to the DrugStars company
- b. Users (users of the app) who allocate sponsor funding for the DrugStars company
- c. Health charities that receive sponsor funding from the DrugStars company

A fundamental part of the interaction between parties a, b and c above is that:

1. No company sponsor (a) can give any directions as to where the sponsorship funds should be allocated.
2. Only users (b) who have received stars can decide on the allocation of sponsorship funds.
3. All health charities (c) that are approved by the authorities as health charities in their respective countries can receive sponsor funds from DrugStars.

Terminology wise, companies contributing to sponsor funds are categorized as "indirect sponsors of health charities". This means that a company sponsoring DrugStars cannot reasonably be accused of giving money that benefits a specific health charity.

Another important factor to ensure independence and transparency is that a company sponsor (a) of stars cannot give any directions regarding what sponsorship funds should be given to users of a specific pharmaceutical product.

For transparency, DrugStars will annually disclose all sponsoring company (a) contributions to all health charities (c) Health charities publicly disclose the donations that DrugStars have given.

1.3 Compliance review of the DrugStars platform

The service provided has been compliance reviewed against current marketing and medical legislation by the law firm Bech-Bruun with no identified issues. The review can be provided upon request.

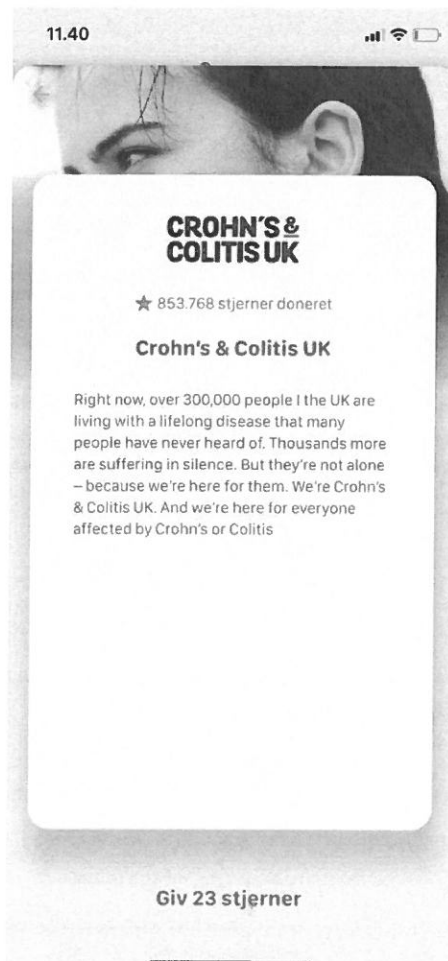

1.4 Health charity page on the DrugStars app

The donator will develop a health charity page in the DrugStars app (picture a) that will be shown to users that have registered to use DrugStars in the same country as the health charity is operating.

2. The obligations of the health charity

The health charity participates based on a no cost setup.

2.1 DrugStars Logo

The health charity agrees to put the DrugStars logo on their website and in the charity's future newsletters with a download link provided by DrugStars.

2.2 Social media

The health charity accepts to appear on social media as part of the DrugStars donation process with #healthcharity. Each exposure is based on the DrugStars app user activation of a donation of 50 stars.

The health charity agrees to appear with its logo on www.DrugStars.com as one of the health charities that DrugStars have donated money to.

The health charity agrees to publish all future donations from DrugStars on the charity's social media channels.

2.3 Recruitment of members

The health charity is not obligated to recommending members to download the DrugStars app. However, the more members that download and use the DrugStars app, the more donations the health charity is likely to get. The donor will deliver the materials that the health charity can distribute at no cost.

2.4 Promotion

The health charity is required to create a blog post/write an article in their newsletter/magazine and/or a social media post announcing their partnership with DrugStars. In addition, the health charity is required to share DrugStars via their newsletter/magazine/social media at least once each quarter and work proactively with us on a form of content each year.

2.5 Health Charity Logo

The Health Charity gives permission to DrugStars to use their logo as part of the online and offline collaboration. Use of health charity's logo offline can only be done after prior written approval.

Online use of patient charities logo can be done without approval, provided that the application is in connection with the app, or communication about the collaboration in general in digital media. DrugStars ApS is in addition to what follows from the contents of this agreement, unauthorized to use patients' name and logo, trademarks or other business features without prior consent.

After any termination of the agreement between the parties, DrugStars ApS is totally unauthorized to use the name and logo of the patient association, trademarks or other business characteristics.

3. Termination


This Agreement shall be effective on the date hereof and shall continue, unless terminated by one of the parties.
